

Errata/Clarifications for Doubleweave Throw Pattern from *Double Your Fun* video

Under Project Steps

2. Clarification: this step doesn't specify that you are working right to left—Step 4 below does. The pattern is written, assuming the accent stripe is on the left. If your stripe is on the right, no worries, just start weaving on the left instead of the right.

4. Starting on the right side of the heddle, take the first Red end threaded in a hole in the back heddle and thread it through the slot to the **RIGHT [pattern says left]** of the corresponding hole in the front heddle. Take care to find the correct slot or your heddles won't line up properly.

9. Place Pick-up Stick A: Put both heddles in the down position. Pick up all the **RED yarns [pattern says Berry]** as demonstrated in the video, following the same pattern when you reach the Plum.

13. Starting on the right side, weave 13 1/4." Rose, **3 1/2." Plum [pattern says 1 3/4"]**, and 13 1/2" Cherry using the Pattern Repeat above. Maintain your weft angle and advance often as you do so to keep the selvages even. Weave a few inches of scrap yarn to keep the weft secure during finishing.
