It requires a separate log in and password, however, once you have a Thinkific account, you can register for classes and weave-alongs as you wish under that account. As long as you maintain an account, you have access to all the classes and weave-alongs you have registered for, 24/7.

You don't have to be a patron to register for classes, but your support is very much appreciated and patrons get deep discounts and patron-only content for their ongoing support.
